Dear Sirs:

Our firm has been retained by Thomas Fetzer to pursue litigation against each of you for the libelous and defamatory statements and the republication of libelous and defamatory statements contained in an email by Mr. Curtis Wright of May 19, 2009. We are currently investigating the facts and preparing a lawsuit against Mr. Wright, WWAY TV 3, and WLTT 93.7 and 106.3 FM. Particularly outrageous is Mr. Wright's intentional republication of an anonymous letter filled with statements which are obviously false, inflammatory and damaging to Mr. Fetzer. Please be advised that Mr. Fetzer considers the republication of this letter actionable, and any further republication of the letter or Mr. Wright's e-mail will only add to Mr. Wright's and WWAY's liability. We also warn you against any other false statements about Mr. Fetzer, all of which would be considered actionable.

Pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 99-1, we are providing notice as required to a radio or television station prior to commencing a lawsuit for libel or slander. The defamatory e-mail was sent by Mr. Wright on Tuesday, May 19, 2009 at approximately 11:08 pm with the anonymous letter

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attached, and was directed to numerous recipients. In accordance with the five day notice contemplated by that statute, we anticipate filing suit on May 26, 2009.

Finally, we must advise you of certain obligations to preserve evidence. In accordance with federal and state rules of court, a party who reasonably anticipates litigation is under an obligation not to destroy documents or electronic information that may be relevant to the case. We hereby notify you that litigation will be commencing, and any destruction, discarding, altering, or deleting potentially relevant documents and electronically stored information would be a violation of your duty to preserve that evidence. If you have any questions regarding your obligations in this regard, we strongly advise that you consult counsel.

We anticipate forwarding a verified complaint and summons for service of process on you on Tuesday, May 26, 2009. All communication with Mr. Fetzer should be directed to our firm.
